**LINDA EVANS**

Golden Globe Award-Winning Actress, Author & Speaker

**September 15, 2021**

*Aging Gracefully*

Actress Linda Evans has personified beauty and grace to American television viewers for over five decades, from her role as Audra Barkley, a daughter of the Old West on *The Big Valley* (1965-1969 on ABC), to glamorous Krystle Carrington on *Dynasty* (1981-1989 on ABC), to *Hell's Kitchen*, the British competitive cooking reality show she won in 2009.

For her role as Krystle, wife of oil multi-millionaire played by John Forsythe and counterpart to Joan Collins' evil Alexis, Linda was nominated five times for the Golden Globe Award for Best Actress in a TV Drama series (1982-1986). She won in 1982, sharing the honor with Barbara Bel Geddes of rival prime time television soap opera *Dallas*.

Linda won five People's Choice Awards and was nominated for an Emmy Award for Outstanding Lead Actress in a Drama Series in 1983. Linda earned a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.



**JIMMY TINGLE**

Humorist, Comedian, Satirist

*Uncommon Sense - Society's Absurdities*

Jimmy Tingle is one of the top social and political humorists in America and has worked in various media from the early 1980s to the present day.

He grew up in Cambridge, Massachusetts, where the social, political and economic diversity laid the groundwork for his development as a performer and satirist. After graduating from Southeastern Massachusetts University in 1977, Tingle emerged on the comedy scene in Boston quickly rising through the ranks.

He then completed two seasons with *60 Minutes II* on CBS as a humorist and worked as a contributor and satirist for MSNBC. He appeared on numerous national television talk shows. Film credits include *Head of State*, *Next Stop Wonderland*, *Boondock Saints* and *By the Sea*. He also wrote, produced and starred in the documentary film *Jimmy Tingle's American Dream*.

His theatrical credits include writing and starring in four one-person shows directed by Larry Arrick.



**CAROLINE WINTERER**

Historian, author.

**March 16, 2022**

*"The Remarkable Genius of Benjamin Franklin"*

Caroline Winterer is an American historian at Stanford, and holds the William Robertson Coe Professorship. She's committed to opening up history to the general public by showing how the past is exciting, relevant—and unstuffy.

She received a Genius award from the Smithsonian Institution for mapping Ben Franklin's social network and has appeared in television documentaries on PBS and elsewhere.

The most recent of her five books is *American Enlightenments: Pursuing Happiness in the Age of Reason* (2016). She writes for the general public in publications like the *New York Times*, the *Washington Post*, and the *Los Angeles Review of Books*.

An award-winning teacher, Winterer is an elected member of the Society of American Historians (for distinguished contributions to the writing of history) and the American Antiquarian Society and is a Distinguished Lecturer of the Organization of American Historians.

*"Everybody Has a Story"*

Steve Hartman brings viewers moving stories from unique people he meets in his feature segment *On the Road*.

Hartman is also well known for his multiple award-winning feature series, *Everybody Has a Story*. He proved the adage by tossing a dart at a map of America and randomly picking an interview subject. Hartman has produced more than 120 such pieces.

He has won dozens of prestigious awards for his work: An Alfred I. DuPont-Columbia University Award, three national Emmy awards and nine RTNDA/Edward R. Murrow awards.

Previously Hartman was a columnist for *60 Minutes Wednesday* and a correspondent for two CBS News magazines, *Public Eye with Bryant Gumbel* (1997-98) and *Coast to Coast* (1996-97).

After graduating from Bowling Green State University in 1985 with a degree in broadcast journalism, Hartman began his career in Toledo at WTOL-TV as an intern and general assignment reporter.

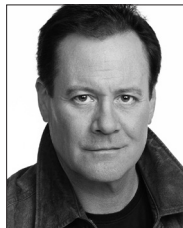
**TOM TORO**

Tom Toro's insightful and hilarious cartoons have appeared in *The New Yorker* over 200 times in the last decade. His work has also appeared in *Paris Review*, the *New York Times*, *Harvard Business Review*, and *American Bystander*.

*The New Yorker Cartoon Encyclopedia* features a dozen essays written by Toro and his literary wordplay has also been showcased on the *New Yorker* cartoon editor's blog and Toro's very own graphic memoir.

Toro graduated cum laude from Yale, where he received the Betts Prize for his literary work while also serving cartoon editor for the *Yale Herald*.



**CHRIS LEMMON**

Actor, Producer and Author

Chris Lemmon has starred in over twenty-five feature films, including *Just The Ticket*, *Lena's Holiday* and *That's Life* and in television series including *Knot's Landing*, *Thunder In Paradise*, *Studio 59*, *Brothers & Sisters*, and *Duet*.

Lemmon graduated from the California Institute of the Arts with degrees in classical piano, composition and theatrical arts. He went on to appear in numerous stage productions.

He presently writes and produces feature films and television. His recently published memoir, *A Twist of Lemmon*, is a tribute to his father Jack Lemmon, who died in 2001. Lemmon shares family tales, intimate father-son conversations, and anecdotes from and about his dad.

He is presently in pre-production for his film *Publicity Stunt*, which he wrote and produced, and in which he will star. The film will be helmed by *Big Fat Greek Wedding* director, Joel Zwick.
