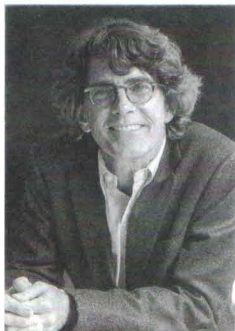

Sept. 21, 2022

Sean Hartley is the Director of *Theater@Kaufman*, the musical theater division of the Kaufman Music Center. He curates, produces and often hosts the series *Broadway Close Up and Broadway Playhouse*. His works for television include songs for the Disney Channel's *The Book of Pooh and Bear In the Big Blue House*. His lecture today is an overview of Broadway musical history, focusing on four revolutionary shows: *Show Boat, Oklahoma, Company and Hamilton*.



Nov. 16, 2022

Louis Masur is a Distinguished Professor of American Studies and History at Rutgers University. He is a cultural historian who has written on a variety of topics. His lecture, *Hamilton vs. Jefferson: The Rivalry that shaped America* explores the Federalist Party and Jefferson's bitter fight of it. Hamilton, an orphan born in the West Indies, was like a son to George Washington and perhaps should have been like a brother to Thomas Jefferson.



Mar. 15, 2023

Maxwell King is the former President of the Pittsburgh Foundation and the Heinz Endowments. From 1999 to 2008, he led the disbursements of about \$500 million in grants primarily in western Pennsylvania. His lecture on *The Good Neighbor: The Life and Work of Fred Rogers* changed the face of children's television. The first full length biography of Fred Rogers is the definitive portrait of a beloved figure, cherished by multiple generations.



Apr. 19, 2023

Jean Kilbourne is internationally recognized for her groundbreaking work on the image of women in advertising and for her critical studies of alcohol and tobacco advertising. Jean has twice received the Lecturer of the Year Award from the National Association for Campus Activities. She is known for her wit and warmth and her ability to present provocative topics in a way that unites rather than divides.
